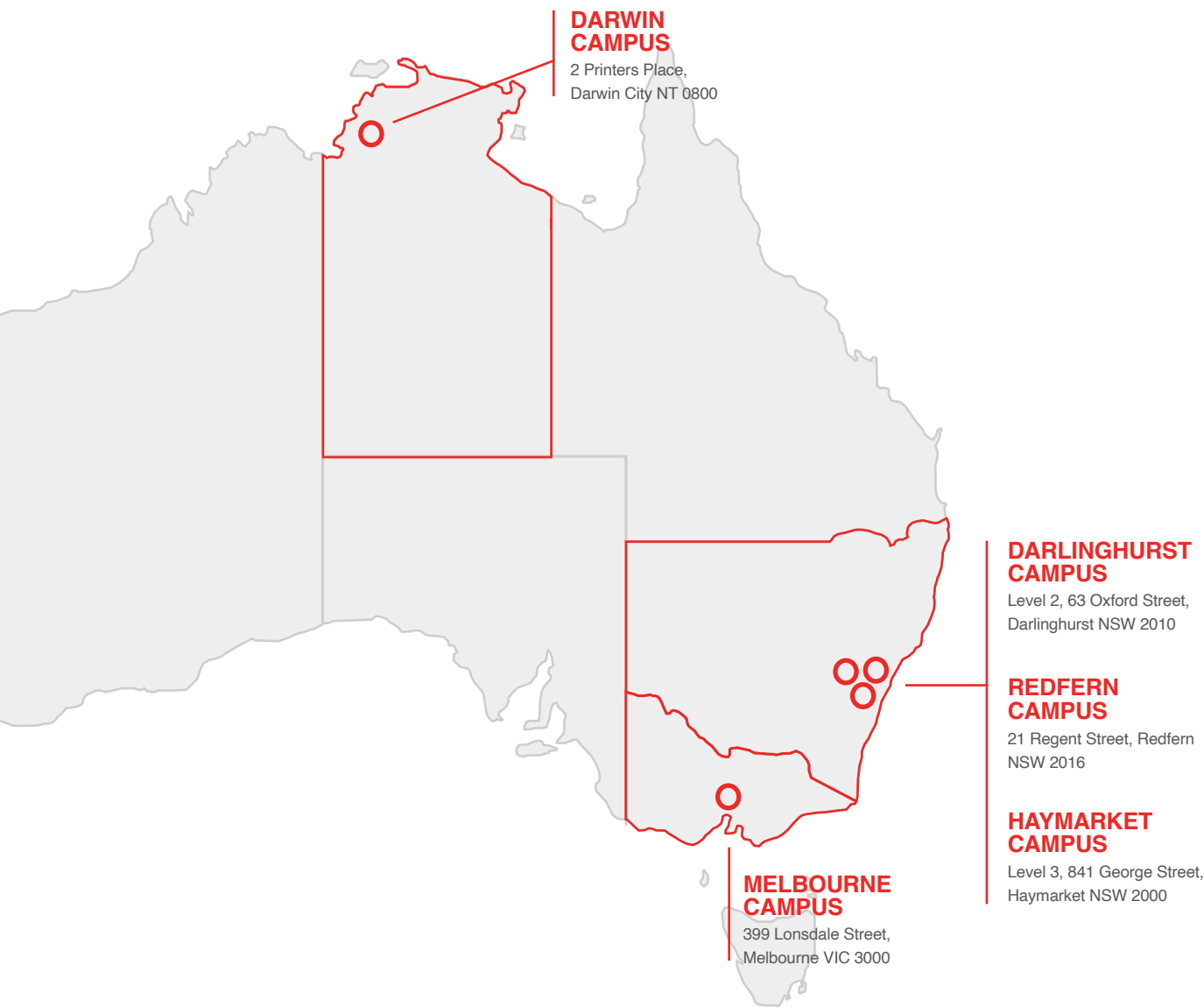

## Bachelor of Business

### MAJORS

#### ACCOUNTING MAJOR

Graduates of the Accounting major gain the essential skills and knowledge to launch a career in accounting. The role has evolved beyond finance to include strategy, corporate governance, and information systems expertise. Students are eligible to apply for membership with CPA Australia, Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand (CA ANZ), and the Institute of Public Accountants (IPA), enhancing their professional credentials.

#### HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT MAJOR

The Hospitality Management major prepares students for leadership roles in the hospitality industry. They gain a strong foundation in hospitality and business management, along with practical problem-solving skills and industry expertise. Graduates develop the ability to adapt to change and a commitment to lifelong learning.

#### INFORMATION SYSTEMS MAJOR

The Information Systems major equips students with technical and analytical skills to assess and implement information systems in modern organisations. Alongside core business studies in accounting and management, students work on real-world projects, developing practical solutions. # ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

## UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

Successful completion of Year 12 or equivalent with an ATAR of 65 or above. Satisfactory completion of an approved Tertiary Preparation Program, Tertiary Orientation Program, or a Foundation Year Program through an accredited institution of higher education offered at Australian Universities, TAFE Institutes or government approved Registered Training Organisations (RTOs). Completion of a Certificate IV or higher. Admission to candidature for an undergraduate course at an Australian university which achieve equivalent point.

## GRADUATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMS

Successful completion of a bachelor's degree from an Australian higher education institution or overseas equivalent. Successful completion of a Graduate Certificate (or equivalent) in similar discipline from an Australian higher education institution or overseas equivalent. Equivalent prior learning including at least five years relevant professional experience that demonstrates potential to pursue graduate programs. Completion of a relevant postgraduate preparation program.

## MASTER PROGRAMS

Successful completion of a bachelor's degree from an Australian higher education institution or overseas equivalent. Students enrolling into graduate programs, particularly in ICT programs, require a bachelor's degree from an Australian higher education institution or overseas equivalent in a discipline containing mathematics up to year two level. Successful completion of a Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma from an Australian institution or overseas equivalent. Evidence of a minimum of two years relevant industry experience at managerial level. Successful completion of an approved Graduate Qualifying Program from an Australian higher education institution or overseas equivalent.

## RESEARCH PROGRAMS

A Master Degree (AQF Level 9) or Bachelor (Honours) degree from CIM or any other approved institution. A three-year undergraduate degree and a graduate diploma at a Weighted Average Mark (WAM) of 70 percent or higher. A three-year undergraduate degree at a Weighted Average Mark (WAM) of 70 percent or higher, plus a minimum of one year's relevant work experience. A qualification recognised as equivalent by the National Office of Overseas Skills Recognition (NOOSR). Alternative qualification/s and/or experience may be considered to be of equivalent scope and standard to those listed above by the Academic Board of the Institute.

Minimum Age Requirement: 18+ Years

# HOW TO APPLY

Applying to study at the **Canterbury Institute of Management (CIM)** is a simple step-by-step process. Here's how to get started:

- You must be **at least 18 years old** to apply for any undergraduate or postgraduate programme
- Review the **entry requirements** and ensure you provide evidence with your application.
- Complete the **application form** in full, making sure all sections are accurately filled out.
- Attach **certified copies of your academic transcripts** and any supporting qualifications.
- If you're applying for **advanced standing (credit transfer)**, include course outlines and certified copies of your previous qualifications.
- Ensure that **all supporting documents are certified as true copies**. Applications without complete documentation may be delayed.

 Once complete, submit your application and supporting documents through our online portal.

# FEE HELP

Study Now, Pay Later

## WHAT IS FEE-HELP?

FEE-HELP is a government loan that covers all or part of your tuition fees, allowing you to focus on your studies without upfront payments. Repayments are made gradually through the tax system once your income reaches the repayment threshold.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- To apply for FEE-HELP, you must:
- 1. Be an Australian citizen OR hold a permanent humanitarian visa OR be a New Zealand Special Category Visa (SCV) holder meeting specific criteria.
  - 2. Be enrolled in an eligible CIM course at least by the census date.
  - 3. Have not exceeded the FEE-HELP loan limit set by the Australian Government.
  - 4. Submit a valid Tax File Number (TFN) and FEE-HELP application form.



FEE-HELP makes higher education more affordable and accessible, giving you the freedom to invest in your future without financial pressure.
